We're looking for a part-time Script Apprentice to help us ensure the scripts we receive from top studios are written in the proper screenplay format needed to ingest into our StoryFit Engine.

You'll read famous and lesser-known scripts, new and old alike. This is a great opportunity for a Hollywood hopeful to gain insight into technology's impact in the entertainment, film, and television industry, as well as a chance to improve your screenwriting abilities.

Our specific formatting process comes with a learning curve, which our Script Associates will train, guide, and help you to learn. Indicate you've read this job description thoroughly by noting your favorite fictional character in the body of your email application.

Responsibilities:

- Read and reformat scripts to ensure proper screenplay format needed to ingest into our Story Engine
- Keep track of scripts worked on in the internal database
- Export and label scripts properly and file in the correct shared folders
- Progress to the point of no longer needing a second pair of eyes to review your work
- Reach weekly goals set out by the team leader - roughly around 15-20 scripts per week
- Respond promptly to ASAP script requests (this isn't a full-time job and we don't expect you to work more than your allotted time, but the ability to communicate your schedule is key)

- Bachelor's Degree (or in progress) in Film-TV-Communications
- Extreme attention to detail, formatting, and grammar
- Ability to quickly catch grammatical errors
- Interest in the entertainment industry
- Basic understanding of script format and screenwriting rules
- Good communication and responsiveness to feedback
- Time management and adherence to project deadlines
- A love for reading and strong interest in screenwriting
- Knowledge of script formatting software (WriterDuet/Final Draft/Celtx/Fade In, etc.)
